wk	date	The Plan, the prep, the goal...
		Everyone should have sorted through the drum, guitar and bass tracks, made it their own and wrote about the process
10	5 dec	If you did the homework and we have something to overdub – like guitars and vocals, you will be in studio B. If we don't have anything to overdub, we will begin the EQ and Dynamics lessons. Then we'll move to the lab to practice.
11	12 dec	Assuming we got overdubs, then a mix is due. We will listen to your mixes, eval the use of automation and signal processing and instruct where necessary.
12	19 dec	Full band ANALOG recording. You have two weeks to mix this. You are welcome to submit mixes in progress so that we can successively approximate together (geek talk for fine tuning the mix).
